### FARM SORTING INSTRUCTIONS:

**Remove ALL dung & stained fibre, also 2<sup>nd</sup> cuts to the best of your ability. These WILL devalue your fibre**  
We accept all huacaya fibre < (finer than) 35 microns in TWO lengths: SHORT 1.5"-3.5" and LONG 3.5" – 6"  
Sort each animal into smaller individual homogenous bags of fibre- Keep in mind the length variation.

- 1) Neck, cleaned of 2<sup>nd</sup> cuts.
- 2) Off sorts from blanket, a little courser than the blanket
- 3) 2<sup>nd</sup> off sorts from blanket, legs, belly and are a little courser than first off sorts IF < 35 microns.
- 4) More sorts as needed. **Keep in mind to separate short (1.5" to 3.5") from long (3.5" to 6").**
- 5) Carefully fold or slide (using cardboard) the blanket into a large clear plastic bag keeping it as intact as possible.

Please try to have the fibre as uniform as possible in fineness, length and colour in each of the bags. Put these smaller lot bags into the larger clear blanket.

Please use one form per animal inserted into the larger blanket bag.
